



Orson Hyde's mission travels, June–December 1841. A member of the Quorum of the Twelve Apostles, Orson Hyde traveled extensively to fulfill his call to seek information about the potential return of Jewish communities to Jerusalem. During the period covered by this volume, Hyde visited London, Amsterdam, Frankfurt, Constantinople, and Jerusalem, among several other major cities. On 24 October 1841, before beginning his journey home, Hyde offered a prayer on the Mount of Olives in Jerusalem to dedicate the land for the gathering of the Jews.
